

- 2.6 to provide weekend courses on organic gardening, allotment gardening, etc linking to the Victorian heritage of the site
- 2.7 to involve local children from the neighbouring Communities First area in growing and using products from the garden
- 3.1 to provide outdoor educational experience through developing the fishing pond.
- 3.2 to provide work opportunities through developing a small garden shop facility and light catering for visitors.
- 4.1 to provide a nature trail by extending the pathway around the site.
- 4.2 to provide a history/heritage centre for the site by using pictorial/ aural records and exhibits.
- G.1 to monitor the effectiveness of the project by measuring the impact of our operations through social accounting and social audit.
